The range of the choir's repertoire is shown by the fact that it has shared the platform with full scale orchestras, some of the leading brass bands in the country and with The Spinners folk group at the St. George's Hall in Liverpool. In the best traditions of male voice choir singing, the Choir regularly takes part in massed choir concerts, and have appeared at Hanley with Biddulph, Crewe and Haydock male voice choirs and the Grimethorpe Colliery Band. They also have strong links with Liverpool and Runcorn Highfield choirs.

The Choir is in constant demand for concerts, entertaining pensioners and singing for various charities, and they have broadcast on several occasions. They do not confine their activities however, and they have regularly taken part in music festivals and eisteddfods, holding their own against some of the country's best choirs. The choir are often accompanied by the ladies of Little Sutton Singers and they have won several awards when appearing together.

The Choir is self supporting and its income is derived from the subscriptions of the members, supplemented by fund raising efforts and prize money. Members come from all parts of the Wirral and include factory employees, works managers, shop assistants, lecturers, office workers, policemen, pensioners, and a host of other occupations. There is always a warm welcome for any men who are interested in singing and would like to join the Choir.
